INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Decide Where to Go

□ Complete 10 activities between Memorial Day Weekend & Labor Day. All numbered items count as 1 activity.

□ All events count as new.

Step 2: Take Photos #jerseyshoregirlscouts #gsoutdoors

Take a photo at each location; make sure that you are in it. Selfies are ok.

Step 3: Create a Photo Collage

□ Creating a collage is easy! There are many different apps that you can download to your phone. Or use a free online collage site, such as <u>Photo-collage.net</u> and <u>photocollage.com</u>.

Step 4: Notify Council

□ Register for your patch & email your collage by Sept. 10. REQUIRED EMAIL to <u>customercare@jerseyshoregirlscouts.org</u>. Include (1) Girl Name (2) Troop Number/iGirl (3) Parent email. Patches will be distributed at Oct leader meetings. Don't register until you have completed the collage
